

TRAVELER NOTIFICATION – CONSUMER DISCLOSURE NOTICE

Over the recent years the travel industry has become increasingly more intricate and complex. This form has been developed as a service to you in an attempt to better prepare you for your upcoming trip and to alleviate any misunderstanding in the planning and execution of the trip.

Please read this notice as it constitutes part of your contract for travel related services.

For each change and/or cancellation initiated by the traveler (or purchaser) of said travel related services, for any reason, the following processing fee schedule will apply:

- *\$50 per person for cancellation of reservation after deposit has been received by Sanditz Travel.*
- *All Sanditz Travel processing fees are in addition to any other fees that may be assessed by the supplier of your travel related services.*

Sanditz will waive its cancellation fee if travel insurance is purchased and a valid claim is presented and subsequently paid. Sanditz waiver of fees does not apply if vendor waiver coverage or insurance is purchased.

Please note that in the event of a change or cancellation, refunds from the travel supplier may take up to 6 weeks or longer for processing. Upon receipt of a refund from the travel supplier, refund checks will be made payable to the name of record on the receipt or invoice provided with your initial payment. In most (not all) cases credit card payments will be refunded to the credit card and any change/cancellation processing fees will be charged to that credit card by Sanditz to cover any change or cancellation fees.

Sanditz strongly recommends that you protect your travel investment by purchasing travel insurance. Travel insurance may also protect you against additional costs due to unforeseen changes or cancellations after final payment has been made. Your travel counselor is pleased to review various options with you when securing your reservation. You are under no obligation to purchase travel insurance, although we do strongly recommend it. **Cancellations MUST be for covered reasons and according to the terms and conditions of the individual program you purchase.**

Sanditz is not the supplier or source of the travel services being arranged on your behalf and acts solely as an agent for the supplier. The supplier(s) whose name(s) appear on your receipt or itinerary are those who are responsible for providing the travel services you are purchasing. Sanditz will not be responsible for breach of contract, failure to comply with any laws such as "Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)", any intentional or negligent actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers that result in any loss, damage, delay, inconvenience or injury to traveler(s) or traveler(s)' companions or group members.

Unless the term "guaranteed" is stated in writing on your tickets, or itinerary, Sanditz does not guarantee any of the suppliers' rates, bookings, reservations, connections, scheduling or handling of baggage or other personal effects. Sanditz will not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses to any traveler in connection with terrorist activities, social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, abnormal conditions or developments, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside of Sanditz's control.

The traveler assumes complete and full responsibility for, and hereby releases Sanditz from, any duty of checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination or other entry requirements of each destination, and all safety and security conditions of such destinations, during the length of the proposed travel.

Sanditz Travel does recommend that US Citizens traveling to Canada, Mexico or the Caribbean, do so with a valid US Passport. - A VISA REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES
- RECONFIRMATION OF ALL FLIGHTS AND FLIGHT TIMES ARE RECOMMENDED BY THE TRAVELER 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE
